Doctoral Degree Graduation Requirements

- Announcement of Exam (AOE) students are required to pass a PhD Comprehensive Examination. The AOE must be submitted to Graduate
 Studies a minimum of two weeks before the scheduled date of the examination. Students must be enrolled and complete a minimum of one
 hours of graduate credit in the term the Comprehensive Examination is taken and must be in good academic standing.
- Comprehensive Examination must be taken before enrolling in dissertation credits. Any dissertation credits completed prior to successfully passing the comprehensive examination cannot be counted toward the required 18 dissertation credits.
- Application for Candidacy (AC) student submits to Graduate Studies after the PhD Comprehensive Examination has been completed and passed. Must be submitted during the same term the Comprehensive Examination is completed and passed.
- Continuous enrollment in PH 699 Dissertation students are required to be continuously enrolled in PH 699 after passing the Comprehensive Examination and up to the term of graduation.
- **Dissertation committee** doctoral candidates initiate the process of selecting the dissertation committee by first arranging for a qualified faculty member to serve as the Director/Chair.
- **Notification of Intent to Graduate** during the term prior to when student intends to graduate, student must notify COPH PhD staff advisor by completing the COPH Intent to Graduate Form.
- Graduation List by the last day of the term in which the COPH Intent to Graduate Form is submitted, student must verify with COPH PhD staff advisor that student is included in the graduation list for the upcoming term. For example, student intends to graduate in spring 2024. Student would submit COPH Intent to Graduate Form to COPH PhD staff advisor sometime in fall 2023. By the last day of the fall 2023 term, student would verify with COPH PhD staff advisor that the student's name is included in the spring 2024 graduation list.
- Verify Academic Transcript student must verify that the academic transcript does not include any incomplete (I) or non-reported (NR) grades. Student will be removed by Graduate Studies from the graduation list if any incomplete or non-reported grades exist.
- Time to Degree student must graduate by the end of the 5th year after completing the PhD Comprehensive Examination.
- Announcement of Exam (AOE) the AOE must be submitted to Graduate Studies a minimum of two weeks before the scheduled date of the dissertation defense. The date of the dissertation defense is set by the student and the dissertation committee.
- Report of Exam (ROE) the report of exam is submitted by the dissertation committee members no later than 2 weeks after the date of the dissertation defense or by the Graduate Studies deadline (see below), whichever is first.
